Kentucky Announces New 2011 IECC 2009/ASHRAE 90.1-2007 Code Training Workshops

The State of Kentucky is upgrading the Kentucky Commercial Building Code (KBC) by adopting the latest commercial building energy standards - IECC 2009/ASHRAE 90.1-2007.

To support this change, the University of Kentucky has teamed with AD Hall and Associates to develop ten new energy code related workshops. These workshops are designed to help architects, engineers, designers and code officials understand the new design and submission requirements, and the related site inspections. These ten workshops will be offered at five regional locations in Kentucky during April and May 2011. The tuition free workshops earn PDH attendance credits. Class size is limited, so apply soon. 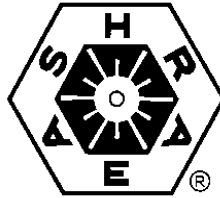
